CASE **STUDY** Air purifiers for dance studios

THE SITUATION

In March 2020 Hilton Hall had to close their doors because of the global Covid-19 pandemic. They took their teaching online to help keep life as normal as possible for their students, but also started planning the best and safest way of getting the studios open again.

The dance studios have no ventilation systems in place which was restricting the number of students being able to return.

This is when they contacted Camfil, as they had previously worked with us to monitor the studios air quality. THE SOLUTION
